This makes the wood light I weight and perfect for plywood production and with been sustainable. IndoPly Storage and Care Guide

(This guide should be read in conjunction with the IndoPly warranty)

Employ best handling practices when moving panels due to their size/weight. Store panels in dry, well-ventilated conditions, placed horizontally on a flat surface. Avoid over-stacking and keep away from flames or excess heat. Do not store panels in an upright position as this may cause warping.

While our panels are water resistant, they aren't completely waterproof. Care should be taken to ensure to avoid excessive exposure to water, steam, or extreme humidity. Care should also be taken to protect panels from high temperatures caused by steam or heat leaks.



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
